

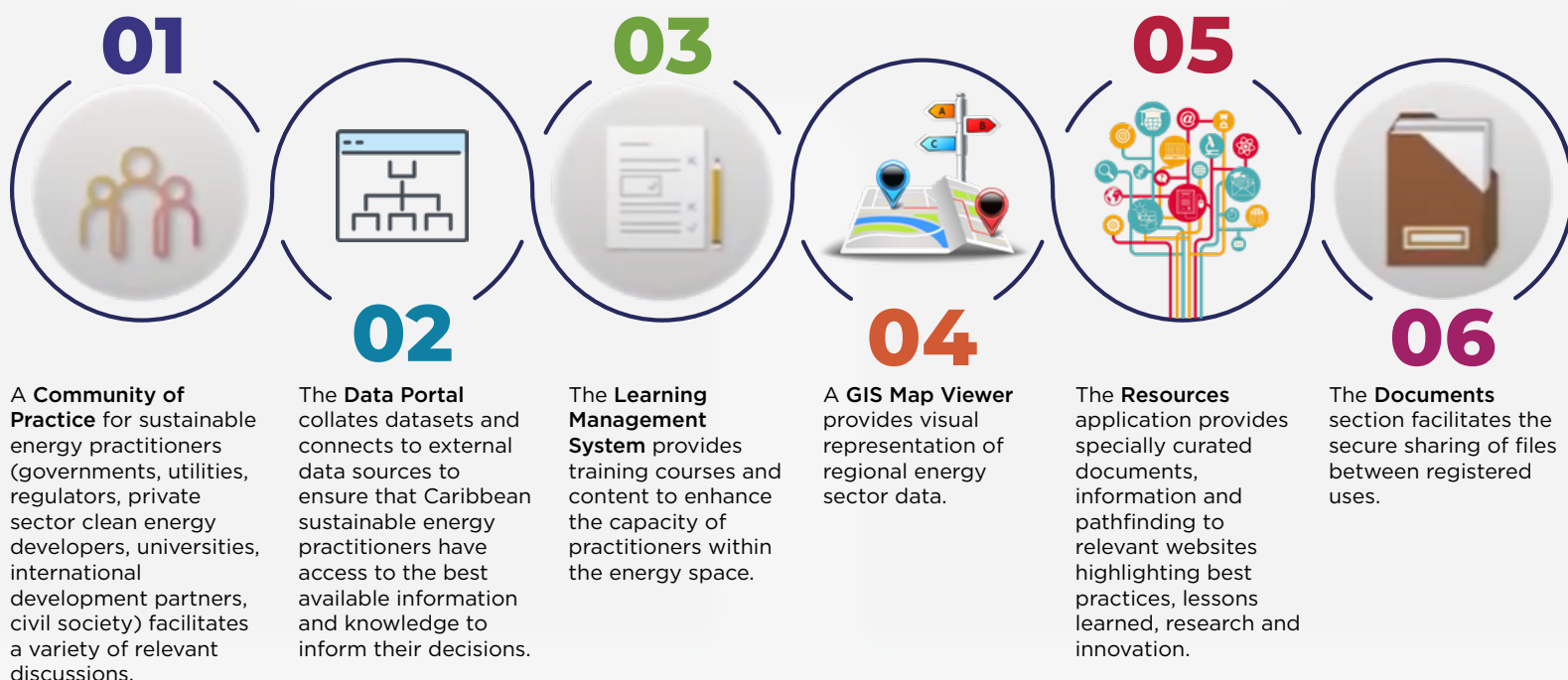
The CARICOM Energy Knowledge Hub (CEKH): What's in it for you!



The CARICOM Energy Knowledge Hub (CEKH) is an intelligent information management system developed to ensure that appropriate, reliable and high-quality information is available and accessible to Caribbean stakeholders.

The CEKH addresses data and information gaps currently existing within the region and enhances the efforts of regional decision makers. The Hub gives access to energy statistics and information required for energy planning, decision support and awareness building.

The CEKH consists of 6 applications:



The CEKH connects to and fuels CCREEE's other flagship programmes with the goal of advancing the sustainable energy transition within the Caribbean. The Integrated Resource and Resilience Planning Programme (IRRP) supports long-term energy planning and the development of short-term action plans which provide clear guidance for the development of the sector and a pipeline of suitable energy projects.

These projects can then be supported by CCREEE's Project Preparation Facility (PPF). During project implementation, lessons learned and other resources are stored within the CEKH for easy access and capacity development of the region's energy professionals.

Registered users of the CEKH have access to:

- Extensive data and information on the Caribbean energy sector conveniently catalogued in one place
- Current and historical energy statistics
- Exclusive content and training material
- Access to energy professionals to have your questions answered
- Data and analytical tools to produce specialised reports
